PRESENTATION

Thermalism is the use, for therapeutic purposes, of thermal water defined as an underground water, naturally pure, with a stable physico-chemical composition and recognized therapeutic qualities.

For our forefathers, thermalism was both rich and complex. Since Antiquity, the relationship between science and the sacred were closely connected but distinct. Such practice revealed intertwined medical, social and religious facets.

In Tunisia, the history of thermal waters dates from two thousand years. It witnessed a significant development during the Roman period when resorting to hot waters was a cult, an art to cure people, and an art of life.

In an increasingly competitive world, thermalism, like other economic sectors, has recently witnessed significant changes.

In such framework, the State decided to privatize the cold water and the hot water sectors. The private sector was entrusted with the mission of investment, operation and management whereas the Office of Thermalism was entrusted with a public service mission and official policy-making.

Most of these springs have been traditionally used for thermal purposes since the Roman times. The number of thermal bath visitors has been increasing year after year, an indication of the importance Tunisians give to those beliefs. In 2009, about 3.3 million people seeking treatment visited these thermal baths.

Tunisia is the second Thalassotherapy destination at a world scale after France. In order to offer a top quality product, renovations and new Thalassotherapy centres projects are under way.

The firm political will of **His Excellency President Zine El Abidine Ben Ali,** the sustained private investor support and the measures to upgrade and better organize the sector are objective factors to encourage private initiative and develop hydrotherapy tourism in Tunisia.
