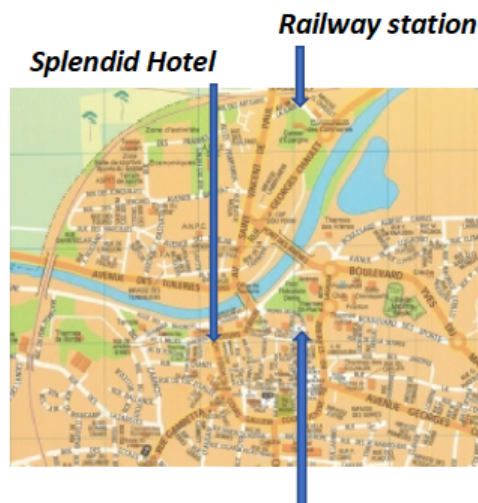
OFFICIAL LANGUAGE OF THE CONGRESS

TRANSPORTS

- **Railways:** Dax station (High Speed Trains from Paris, Biarritz, Bordeaux, Lourdes...).
 - **Train (high speed) from Paris:** 3h22, from 72€
 - From the Dax station easy transports to the hotels of the congress by public free shuttle, taxis, ...
- **Air transport:**
 - **Biarritz airport:** shuttle for Biarritz railway station (Chronoplus N4 or Car express N3 - 1.2 €); train for Dax, 40 mn, from 10 €.

SCIENTIFIC SESSIONS

- **Duration 90 min**
- **Major dedicated session** with one invited keynote lecture and four 10-min-oral communications chosen among the submitted papers.
- **Thematic sessions:** six 10-min-oral communications on a particular topic of the congress.
- **Free papers sessions:** six 10-min-oral communications on miscellaneous.
- **Electronic posters sessions:** twelve poster communications with 5-min-oral presentation of the congress on large screen. The poster sessions will be made of thematic posters sessions and free papers posters sessions. The papers will be address in a poster session according to the demand of the authors and/or the decision of the scientific committee.

ABSTRACTS GUIDELINES

Authors wishing to present papers to the ISMH 45th congress must submit a **4000-character (max, spaces included) abstract** (in English) for review by the Scientific Committee (see *ISMH Abstract template page*).

All abstracts must be submitted electronically via the Submission page.

Abstract submission deadline: 2020 April 30.

Scientific papers on all topics related to the conference themes are welcome for consideration as oral or poster presentation (see topics).

The Scientific Committee will review all received abstracts. The title has to be as clear as possible and the abstract has to provide a precise objective of the research project, the significance of the research, the experimental procedures and equipment used, the results obtained, and the conclusions reached. All abstracts should acknowledge the source of funding that support the work.

Titles and co-authors cannot be changed/added/deleted after the abstract submission. Be certain your information is complete and correct upon abstract submission. All submitted abstracts are considered confidential. To maintain confidentiality, only members of the Scientific Committee will be permitted access to the abstract. The Scientific Committee reserves the sole right to accept or reject any abstract for any reason.

The registration of at least one author during early bird registration is required for paper acceptance and publication in the Conference Proceedings. The presenting author must be registered.

Authors will be notified as early as possible, via email, of the status of their abstracts and will be given detailed instructions regarding their presentations.

ABSTRACT EXAMPLE

TYPE THE TITLE – USE CAPITALS – Times New Roman

Presenting Author (first name in full followed by family name), **Author 2** (initials followed by family name), **Author 3**, etc

University and or company, dept, city, country (no street addresses nor zip codes)

Email of presenting author

Keywords: Maximum five keywords separated by; semi-colons

Introduction

Write your abstract here, use Times New Roman 11 and one and a half line spacing. The entire document cannot exceed two pages (8000 signs, spaces included).

Reference (Durand et al., 2001; Harvey, 2014).

AWARDS

List of the awards

General conditions of application to the different awards

- The delegate applying for an award will have to be registered.
- Invited guests are not eligible to an award.
- The delegate will have to apply formally for an award.
- Application for an award is not compulsory.
- On the abstract submission form the delegate will have to tick the chosen award for the considered paper.
- The jury will determine if the papers are in the scope of the award filed for.
- The candidate to the award will have to be the presenting author.
- A paper will compete only in one category of award.
- A presenting author will be allowed to compete only in one category of awards.
- Particular conditions for the awards will have to be considered according to the information given on the congress website.
